

INSTRUCTIONS TO ALL MONITORS.

August 18, 1942.

The following instructions are to be carried out by all of the monitors in charge of groups.

1. After you leave the gate at the assembly center, keep your group together and lead them to the car, which will have a number on the side of it, which will be given to you in advance.
2. Stay at least fifty feet from the group in front of you to avoid groups being mixed together and causing undue delay.
3. When you arrive at the train keep your group together near the car you have been assigned and remain quiet.
4. When the train commander gives the order to board the train, have your group board the train, and have them seated quickly and to remain seated till the train starts moving, leave all empty seats in one end of the car so they may be counted easily.
5. As soon as your group has been seated, inform them they are ~~to~~ not to use the toilets till after the train starts moving.
6. ALL MONITORS are held responsible that their groups will remain seated till after the train commander has checked the train.
7. A meeting of all MONITORS will be held shortly after the train has started, about 2 hours after departure, instructions will be given upon the call of the train commander when he wants Monitors assembled.
