

Brief Outline of Letter sent to Mr. Dillon S. Myer on March 7, 1944

**DRASTIC LABOR CUT:**

1. To make the relocation center as livable and productive as wartime conditions will permit.
  - a. Conditions not applied to the residents
  - b. Impossible to maintain adequate comfort
