SUMMARY OF CURPENT JOB OFFER SITUATION

With the exception of some of the better administrative position and war plant work, oractically every other type of position is available in this area even though they may not be on file with the War Relocation Authority. It has been found that applications made at United States Employment Service has resulted in many resettlers obtaining the type of employment desired and for which they are qualified.

SUMMARY OF CURRENT HOUSING SITUATION

Certificates of eligibility have been issued to a number of resettlers in essential work for renting of remodeled war housing units and a number of them are not living in such units. It is anticipated additional units will be available for resettlers in this area, otherwise the housing situation remains about the same. Furnished apartments for families are difficult to find.
