I am in receipt of your letter today and since Johnny was writing to you today, I am going to include this in his letter.

In regard to those pipe wrenches, according to the inventory we made out before we left, it should be in that box in the barn but since you couldn't find it there, there is only one more place it could be. I thought I left it in the barn but I imagine in the rush before the evacuation, I used it and forgot to put it back exactly as the inventory stated. I don't know for sure but I think its inside the house. You know, the hallway, well, anyway up theres a box there with lots of tools in such as pliers, hammers, squares etc. and I am sure the the pipe wrenches are in there. If the box isn't in the hallway, its in the last hallway room where all the things are stored. Its either in one of these places and if it isn't in there, I'm afraid I don't know where it is. Heres hoping that you will find it there whenever you're up that way.

I was worried to hear that the pump was leaking and I hope by this time, the Winklers have taken care of the matter.

I also would like to thank you for taking care of our war risk insurance and for putting you to all of these various troubles all the time. Thanking you again for doing so much for all of us all the time. Best regards to all from all,
