Sept. 30 - 1945

Dear Mrs. Perry -

I received your letters of the 13<sup>th</sup> and 15<sup>th</sup> and thank you very much.

Making this just a short note today to let you know that we and Fred Johnson's family will be leaving Arroyo Wednesday 26<sup>th</sup> around 1:30 in the afternoon.

Can't say where we'll get there as the trains are hardly on time these days. We should be home by the 29<sup>th</sup> I hope.

We're going to buy tickets for Santa Rosa since the station here claims that's the nearest the train will get to Sebastopol. I understand that the destination of this coach will be Oakland and from there we're supposed to take a bus to San Francisco to San Rafael and catch the Northwestern Pacific to Santa Rosa.

Will let you know when we arrive and shall be looking forward to seeing you all soon.

Until then will be closing with this last letter from Arroyo.
