good will;

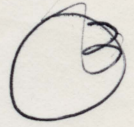
• State Funeral in Methodist Church; packed to death, Effort 1 - Answered the excesses VFW

non-A - threaten

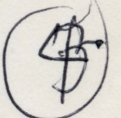
