

LAST WILL AND TESTAMENT

OF

HAJIME JIM AKUTSU

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS: That I, HAJIME JIM AKUTSU, a bachelor, of the City of Seattle, King County, State of Washington, being of sound and disposing mind and memory, and not acting under any duress, menace, fraud or influence of any person, circumstances or matter whatsoever, do freely and voluntarily make, publish and declare this my LAST WILL AND TESTAMENT.

FIRST - I order and direct that my body be decently buried under the direction of my executor, hereinafter named, without undue ceremony or ostentation, but with proper regard for my station in life and the circumstances of my estate.

SECOND - I direct that my executor, hereinafter named, as soon as he shall have sufficient funds applicable thereto pay my funeral expenses, the expenses of my last sickness and all my just debts and obligations of every nature, in the order of priority prescribed by the laws of any State or Country where this WILL may be admitted to Probate.

THIRD - I hereby give, devise and bequeath, all my property, both real, personal or mixed, of whatsoever, kind, name and nature, and where-soever situated, of which I may die seised or possessed, or to which I may be entitled at the time of my decease, to my beloved father, Kiyonosuke Akutsu, and my beloved mother, Nao Akutsu, to be divided equally between them, share and share alike.

FOURTH- I hereby nominate and appoint my beloved father, Kiyonosuke Akutsu, of Seattle, County of King, State of Washington, to be the EXECUTOR of this LAST WILL AND TESTAMENT; and I further direct that he shall not be required to give any bond or security for the proper discharge of his duties.

FIFTH - I hereby revoke any and all former wills executed by me or in my behalf.
