Just happened to be getting rid of ~~the~~ ^{some} paperwork of a research project I had just finished when I happened on this photograph.

It was taken by me in 1944 in an area known as the "railroad corridor" The flat ~~ground~~ ^{valley} where the railroad come from Mandalay to Terminate at Myitthaingia. We were in a firefight at a collection of basha huts called PINTHE. The unit I was with was the Royal ~~W~~ WELCH FUSILIERS a crack British unit of the British 36th Division detailed to Gen. Stilwell.

I don't know the name of the Misi soldier/interpreter or that of the British Intelligence officer. It certainly shows a Misi doing his job right at the point of combat. With the above information you
