Here are a few pictures from
1944:

The one at the American
Mission School was taken three
days before the fall of Myittha,.
I was working with the 150 regt.
50th Division Chinese army. The
area was truly hot. Another photo
and myself were moving up to
the line while under some sniper
fire. I had just come from behind
the wall of the building and was
looking for my next cover before
moving out -

The Tripod Eyemo was used
during some documentaries between
~~starts~~ stints in combat.

A tank knocked out by Japanese
fire. The tank was from the Chinese-
American Tour Group. I had just gotten

Out of 20th General Hospital - Had
typhus.

Medics putting a Davis splint
on my broken leg after being
hit by ~~an~~ freedrop. Mass Task
Force 11/24/44.

Tomorrow, the 6th, I will
be going into NYC with my
negative. I have made arrangements
with a lab to get your prints made.
You should receive the shipment by
the end of this week or the
beginning of the next.
