DEFINITION: KIA = KILLED IN ACTION FROM RECORDS
MIA = MISSING IN ACTION DOW = DIED OF WOUNDS
WIA = WOUNDED IN ACTION IJA = INJURED IN ACTION
WIA/NOT HOSPITALIZED = WOUNDED BUT WAS NOT ADMITTED ^{HOSPITAL}

MOST DOCUMENTS - LITERATURE - BOOKS - NEWS ARE FACTS RECORDED FROM OFFICIAL RECORDS OF HEADQUARTERS OF THE ORGANIZATION WHO ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR LEGAL, STATISTIC, COMBAT STATUS OF MILITARY UNITS SUCH AS THE 442ND. FOR PAY RECORD - PERSONEL - OFFICIAL FILES - DATA STATISTICS. ERRORS DO OCCUR, DUE TO MISSPELLING WRONG INFO, MISTAKES ARE NOT CORRECTED.

442ND HAD TOO MANY SACRIFICE TO NOT RIGHT THESE FORGOTTEN PERSONEL WHO MADE MAXIMUM EFFORT TO NOT BE RECOGNIZED AND REMEMBERED.

Screening Publications several unclear data are evident and with the KIA/MIA the names in questions are completely NOT THERE, and this FACT is not right and needs to be CORRECTED

LIST FOLLOWS MAINLY OF CASUALTIES, BUT THIS IS NOT THE ONLY DISCREPANCY THAT NEED ATTENTION, AT LEAST WHILE PEOPLE WHO KNOWS THE FACTS ARE HERE AN EFFORT CAN BE STARTED TO SET THE RECORD AND HONOR THESE MEN TO BE REMEMBERED.

This list includes statistics mainly from The Book "Americans" by Orville C. Shirey and Reunion Books - literatures of the 442nd and "Go For Broke" by Chester Tanaka and Do for Broke Inc.

Because I do not have the Defense Dept official documents and the publications are dated - The Book "Americans" are statistics of Dec 1946, more follow up is needed to complete what has been started.

From Records compared the list includes names of Casualties of the 442nd which show KIA/MIA But due for some reason do not appear on HONOR ROLLS - MONUMENTS - RECORDS AND FORGOT.

1. KIA/MIA ON stone list and not others.
2. Because of Names and spelling Cause Confusion.
3. Names oriental and listed in English.
4. Listed MIA officially in time declared KIA Disposition.
5. WIA on organization record, admit to hospital and dies are not proper recorded.
6. MIA and was taken POW STATUS unknown.
7. ANGLO-officer served with 442nd some listed But some KIA/MIA names not included
8. 442nd Fought some Battles - Bodies unidentified or recovered to be documented.
9. Due to some atrocities the enemy did not take POW and have some Mass graves.
