The school moved every 2 year for larger facility; demanding more enlisted men in the Pacific. (MIS)

No time for the military activity but study and road marches.

In the Turkey Farm, 350 EM arrives with only summer cloth on, had to transfer them to the Reception Center at 1PM and get them back 5PM to eat after they get thier clothings.

The school enlarged 10 times, my casual company had 1700 EM to be ready to fill where graduated left, the faeldhouse was packed with double bed-bed kitchens, supply-rooms, where-ever space could be found and for the classes; Pay-day tooked us three days to pay

WRA are closing as mens were process and shipped out (not being able to help familys relocate out) it was a mess.
