Came to SF in 1941, when husband was ordered to 4th Army Intelligence school to study Japanese. Had a baby about one year old.

In June 1942, The Wrights were assigned to be escorts for Isoroku Yamamoto
Sumi Aiso

Shigeharu
Aya Aiso to prevent any anti-Japanese incidents while traveling from SF to Minnesota.

Esther remained in Minneapolis when Eugene took his Language Team to join the Americal Division on New Caledonia, then to Guadalcanal.

Esther came back to Seattle

Could possibly have a file of letters received from the front, much of it telling how Eugene worked with Mamoru Nagai, Haruo

Tanaka, Tets Hayashida and Charley Hamasaki.

Even now 40 years after the war, the Wrights actively maintain the friendships, formed during the war with Staff, faculty and students of NIS
