## I.H.S.A.A. Accepts Hunt; Opener Slated for Friday

Wolverines Track Team to Tangle with Eden In Dedication Meet Next Friday Afternoon

The baseball and track meet with the Eden High Grizzlies, scheduled for last Friday afternoon was postponed due to adverse weather conditions. Dedication of the newly constructed track course was also postponed. The Hunt High Wolverines will play host to the Eden baseball and track team next Friday afternoon, weather permitting.

Now recognized by the Idaho High School Athletic Association, Hunt High has the franchise to compete against outside teams, according to Coach Morris Roth, physical education director.

Inaugurating the '44 baseball season, the Hunt High Wolverines will entangle Coach Charles Hawley's Eden High Grizzlies next Friday afternoon at the local field. The newly organized Wolverine track team will also compete against the visitors in eight events. Under the dedication of the track field, R. S. Davidson, assistant project director in charge of operations, will present the track field to R. A. Pomery, assistant project director in charge of community management, who will receive the dedication in behalf of the high school.

Hunt will be ineligible to participate in the state tournament sponsored annually by the I.H.S.A.A. for, though Hunt will play the teams in the Magic Valley league, the results will not be posted on the league standings. However, the results will affect the opponent's standing stated Roth.

## Meet Your Varsity

With only three lettermen returning among the 20 players on the squad, Coach Tak Akiyama will have a team of fairly green players. Catcher Hank Matsumoto, first baseman Tak Hiya and centerfielder Roy Shiki are the members from last year's varsity. Although inexperienced, the Wolverines have a squad with many promising rookies, stated Akiyama.

Covershortstop is Tom Hayashi who is battling it out with Frank Sakai for that vital position. Haak Matsumoto, another dangerous hitter is handling the key-stone slot.

Out in the gardens, Roy Shiki will play center field, with Dutch Wakabane, Jun Iwada and Jim Kuga after the other two positions. In addition to the three regulars, Akiyama has eight outfielders in reserve.

## Mont. Detention Center Closed

The Department of Justice announced March 23 that it is abandoning the Montana detention center for alien enemies and is returning the property to the custody of the army.

The detention center has been under the jurisdiction of the Immigration and Naturalization Service since April 1941. The first group of internees quartered there were 482 crew members of the "Conte Biancamano," an Italian vessel which was seized shortly after the outbreak of war in the Canal Zone. It has been used exclusively for the quartering of the other Italian seamen and for a smaller group of Japanese civilians while awaiting hearings before Alien Enemy Hearing Boards.
