WE'RE GOING TO WYOMING & IDAHO WASHINGTON-WYOMING OREGON-IDAHO

Washington residents in the Center, with the exception of those from Clarke County, will leave August 29th and 30th in 2 groups to Hart Mountain Relocation Project, Wyoming.

Groups of 500 or more will leave by two train loads on August 29th and 30th. Plans for 45 people in each coach with a coach captain are being made. There will also be a train captain whose duties will be to arrange dining facilities, babies' formulas, and general welfare of the travelers. Two baggage cars and two dining cars will be provided for each train. All things not personal baggage will sent ahead by freight cars the day before. Further details will be released in the following issues.

The Washington group will join the Pomona Center residents who began their exodus August 9th.

The balance of the residence of this Center, those from Portland and vicinity, and Clarke County, Washington, are to be transferred to the Minidoka Relocation Center Eden, Jerome County, Idaho.

This phase of the relocation movement is to commence approximately on September 6 with contingents of 500 slated to be moved daily until completion. Similar train regulations will be carried out as in the Washington groups.
