WaCsunsegregated
Induction of nisel women into the Women's Arry Corps mede good reading last week for Japanese Americans, but even bottor was the nous thet WIC induction, as had been promised, wes unsegregated.

But in addition, nisei womon are oligiole to serve with all units of the WAC, as attestod to by the acceptance of a nisei, Mis. Cherry Talzagawara, for duty with the air corps, a unit so far closed to men of Japanese ancestry.

It is of utmost importance that nisei, askiag to serve their country, be allowed to $\dot{c} o$ so without discriminatory jolicies being efiected in regerd to them. The worle of the nisei WACs caninot bo overestimated. Besides helping their country fully and concretely they servo as proof that Japanese Americans, too, are part of this country's var efiort.

The looth Infantry Battalion and the Japanese American Combat team at Carap Shelby are duanatuic symbols of tho loyalty of the nisei, and on that score the segregation of thesc units is justifiod.

The nisei soldier hes showm his courage under fire and his worth as a fighter and an Anerican. imen more nisei are inducted, their induction must be unsegregatad. Just as this nation is a country composed of men of all racial ancestries,so must hor army reflect multitudinous racial strains of the population.

Kany moro Japaneso Amorican soldiers vill dio bofom totel victory is won. We cannot ask then to give their lives under the pall of a discriminatory metional policy.--Editorial from Pacific Cittion.
