In clarifjing the state－ ment carriod in the Poston Ghronicle stating that per－ ans registered proviously for expatriation shall be inducted if physically quar lified and not othervise iufêrred，Billier said，＂No mattor if they have signed． for expatriation，they are still American citizens and are thus suoject to the baloctive service act，and if thoy do not accept induction villlingly， they will be sent to feder－ al．prisons．＂

As this is written, medical exaaination is being Eiven to almost two hundred young mon on the project by the arny medical team. The test of obedience to the call-to-arms iy our country confronts these young men and all others who are to follow then. The present polr icy of the selective service progrem calls for eardv induction of the men of hanzauar between the ages of 18 to 26. Those who are nearer 18 than 36 , it may be resumed, will bear nore parental influence in their Uecision than those who are older.

The good influence, or the lack of good influence, which pareats may conver to their sons will have a mariced bearing on the attituce which their sons adopt and the suivequent induction into the Army of the United States. The effect of this influence cannot be over-estineted. Sound thought and jugment of the parents will affect the viewpoint of their sons in their daily associations with each other. ilost of us already are avare of consequences confronting draft ovaders in service of the projects. He hope that our young men in the first group of registrants will exemplify that standard of high courage and determinetion.

The consequences of iraft evasion, ve can be assured, rill not result in those evaders being sent to Tule La;e Segregation Center, All contrary rumors and viempoinvs notwithstanding, this may be regaried as a certaiaty.

## OUR PLEEASURES

Those of us who foel that we will be staying here for ain indefinite period due to personal circumstances, or conveniences, elvays have vanted improvements in the Waily conveniences afforded to us by the WRA.

Ve want roonier apartments. Ve want plentiful supplies of mops, orooms, soaps and other necessities, We want a swimning pool for our youngsters. Ye want pernission to take hiking trips to the foot of the Sierras. So long as this area remains vithin the zone of strategic militaxy area, we will not be granted the last privilege, Other phases of these convenionces caunot be estaulished inmediately by the authority,

We may be certain that the project director and the administrative persominel are avare of these desires on our pert.

Iviliences of impatience on our part will not expedite these requests. \%e have been here tro years, It is not unreasonable to expect that most of us should have, as the joys mould say, "Mised up", by now.

Request for these conveniences, couched in terms of complaints and bickering, ve may be assured, is not a persuasive method.
