 REQUEST EVACUEES' REPORT ON FOREIGN INVESTMENTS

Residents hąirg foreign bonds, securities, bank deposits or properties, are asked to contact the Project Attorney's Office at once about filing a report on Treasury Department Form Trri-500, according to Evacuee Property Oficicer D. S. Bromley.
"Any person othervise required to report is exempt if his foreigh property on kay 31, 1943 had a total value of less than $\$ 10,000$, measured by "cost of face value' or 'market or estimated valuet whichsever is higher; but the exemption does not apply to foreign bonds payable in United States dollars, which must be reported regardless of value.", he said.

Bromley asked rosidents not to confuse Form TRR500 with Form TFP-300, which many persons filed about two years ago.
"Filing of a report on Form TrR-300 does not excuse anyone from fỉing a report on Form TFR-500," he declared.

## INTRODICE BILL TO DEPORT JAPANESE

WASHITGTON, Nay 17.-.-A bill calling for the doportation of all Japenese aliens imnediately following the end of the war was introduced in the House today by Representative Mott (Republican), Oregon, Who declared that Amerieans no longer wish Japanese subjedts "to disgrace our soity."

Mott's peasure vould issue deporfdidion warrents against all llapanese undesirable aluons within 30 deys after the ond of hostilities. $f$

Action is imperative now Mott added, lest postwar propaganda based on the argument that the Japs are "no, longer our enemies" dafeat its approval follaing the conflict.

## Cinamelal aid OFFERED EVACIILES BY RFC

TOPAZ, Utah-EDvacuees whe wish to reenter business may receive financial aid from the Reconstruction Finance Corporation lending prozram, which is designated to aid small business ontorprises, the Topaz Times reported hero recently.

Applications for loans to ostablish or re-establish small businosses will be considered from any typo of business entorprises, including corporations, partnerships or individual businesses.

No loans vill bo made for the purchasing of farm real estate, nevspapers or liquor manufacturing or dispensing firms.

As security a first mortgage or real estate, the plant and equipment, or a first mortgage of chattels, or an assignnent of accounts received are requosted by the RFC. All loans mature in five years and are amortizod on a monthly basis.
80 SICRPGANTS ARRIVE

## SUPREME COINT

RULES OH
NEGRO ISSUES
WASHINGTOI:, May 17.--The
Supreme Court recently refused to budge from it's stand that Negroes have a right to vote in Texas Domocratic primary elections, stated the Los Angeles Times.

Without commont the court declined to reconsider its 8-to-l decision of April 3 that a man cannot be barred from participating in the seloction of "his rulers" because of his color.

The court also cleared the way for broad cons:deration of the problem of Japanese Amorican citizens who were removed, from the West Coast and sent to detention camps under military orders shortly aftor the outbreak of tho war, It agreed to hear the appeal or Hitsuye Endo $s$ s Sacramento, Calif., for release from a war reloca. tion authority camp in Nodoc Gounty, Calif.

Auguments of her appeal will be heard next fall, along with another case challenging the constitutionality of the evacuation orders. The lattor case was filed by Fred Toyosaburo $\mathrm{K}_{0}$ rematsu, talkon from San Leandro, Calif., to a WRA center at Topaz, Utah.
