

CHICAGO SUN COLUNIST DEFENDS NISEI SOLDIERS

Writing in the Chicago Sum, Sugene Rachlis recently devoted a whole column to Capanese Americans in the uniform of the United States Army who are sorving on war fronts throughout the world.

"In much the same way that the men who opened the western routes of this country,fighting for every inch of ground, once said "the only good Indian is a deed Indian," many are now shouting that "the only good Jap is a deed Jap." This sounds too much like Adolf ditler's words of racism.

"Cortainly tho lisci on our alivo and fighting sido, killing Gornens in Europo and Japaneso in A. sia, are good for our side, "Every Japanese American in the uniform of this country is an American. To bracket him with the Japanose who pulled the shoalt attacht on Poarl Harbor and the Japanese who tortured their Philippine prisoners after the fall of that island is completely foreign to American fair play and the philosophy of democracy that is at stale in the wer ... "


