Canadiaimborn citizon of Japanicso encestry, $F_{r}$ ank Tabuchi ves donied pormission to operatc a radio ropair sorvico in iorth Toronto。

This docision was reached by Judgo T. Horbort Barton and liagistrato R. J. Browno after hoaring a djputation of the Bedford Park Businoss 3ion's association opposing the permit, states tho How Canadian.

At tho hearing, Tebuchi told the board: "I did not. come hero of my own choice. I had a businoss in Vancouvor but I had to give it up. Porsonally I think that in a country liko Canada whichis fighting for democracy, I should bo givon moro considoration."

Hardly had tho point driod whon furor bogan, telephono cells voro rocoivod by the mombors of tho Legion committco.

So hostcl was the criticism thet a Jogion committoc hooded by $\mathrm{C}_{\mathrm{a}} \mathrm{rl}$ Hemoh and William Blowott docid od to group tho namos of Jepanoso Amoricans togethor in a special soction on tho honor roll.

This lod to anothorstorm of protest from persons who chargod that thicse so groupod woro boing pickod out for special distinction.

## 'MUST STOP WAR BY <br> STOP HATING'--Brown

A woll lnown comedian of the movic land, Joo $E_{p}$ Brow, roturnod from ontertaining soldiors in Italian and Pacific war fronts. When intorviowod by tho press, ho said:
"Thero's one thing I would liko you to writo about and that's thoso Japanoso Amoricans that somo poople are trying to run out of tho world.
"I sau somo. of them in Italy, 1500 of thom and plenty of them in front. lino hospitals, badly wounded.
"Ono kid from Virginia who was fighting with thom toldmo, 'Thoy're just too big for thoir own skins. Thoy can't do onough.!
"Those Japanoso Amoricans woro wonderful loyel Americans.
"A lot of us aro going to stop hating thom. In fact wo'ro going to stop hating. As long as wo hato, thore will bo war."
