HARCH 15 DEADLINE FOR FILING 1944 INCOME TAX

Merch 15 is tho last day on which to file income tax roturns for the year. 1944, doclared Project Atternoy Alan G. Campbell in warning the residents of the deadline.

If gross income exceeded \$500 and any part of it was from routs or profits or sales of property a formal return smust be filed on Form 1040, end if any withholding receipt is missing form 1040 - must be need.

Anyone who: had taxes withheld from his wages, but did not heve wages or other income exceeding his exemptions mist file a return either on Form 1040 or on his withholding receipts in order to obtain a refund of the taxes which word withhold.
