Fourth of July this year will have poignant meaning and value for an America gripped in a death struggle for the very principles affirmed in the Declaration of Index－ pendence。
＊For American citizens of Japanese anoostry herded into camps and guarded by the bayoneted sentries of their own country．it will be a doubly strange and bewildering daws For they remember，too well，the oar froe Fourth of last year，when they stood along Broadway to obeor tho nisei－ soldiers who marched shoulder to shoulder with American soldiers of all races．

But let us think twice，lost in our understandable and human bitterness，wo dismiss this day with an ironic shrug and a customary wiscorack．

It is too late to argue on the injustio of this gi－ gantio upheaval that finds us today in Manzunar．Our leaders had repeatedly reiterated our willingness to e－ valuate our homes should it ever be considered a mili－ teary necessity．Now we are hero．

Let us stop living in a draamy，nostalgic past．Let us stop wallowing in a mire of self－pity and work out our destinies in a practical manner．

We，nisei，have temporarily put our individual free－ dams on ice so that national morale might remain sound． and the fight for world demooraoy might continuo unfit－ teredo．of all diverse ：Anerioan groups，we are in tho best position to appreciate the blessings of liberty．

For those whose faith in America burned bright－．－who wero onager to give their blood to prove that faith－－this is a difficult test，a Valley Forgo．

On tho day that the gates of Manzanar open wide for us againglet us step out into a victorious America，more vigilant and jealous of the independence we have regain－ ed through patient cosporation and waiting．
