RETURNING NISEL SOLDIERS TO BE AIDED BY NEW FLAN

LAKE GARDA, Italy--White officers of the 442nd American Infentry Regiment, disgusted with the discrimination against persons of Japanese ancestry along the U.S. West Coast, have organized their own replacement plan for the Japanese American vetorans who are now re-

turning to the homoland under the 35 point system, the Army Stars and Stripes reports.

Originated by Liout. William Wolff of Lvanston, Ill., the plan calls for a committee of 'hree regimental officers who interview each Lisei soldier (Comtinued on Page 2)

SEEK OWNERS OF GOODS STORED AT BUDDHIST CHURCH ON MAIN ST.

Evacuce Property Officer David S. Bromley announced that removal of property from the Buddhist Church at 1427 Main Street, Seattlo is necossary and roquosts all porsons using the church for storage to contact him at once.

He also cautioned rosottlers to make arrangements to have their personal property picked up at least one week before departure. Owners should accompany thoir belongings to the crating warehouse at moss hall 4 and remain there while it is being crated.

Form 156 must then be made out by owners in order that shipment can be made. Unless these forms are signed, property cannot be shipped.

Immediately after orated property is moved from the crating warchouse to mess hall 2. each owner should go there and execute the necessary papers.

JUDGE WILSON VOIDS 'DUMMY' LAND SALES

ANGELES So-called LOS "dummy" land sales are void according to a ruling handed down this week by Superior Judgo Emmet H. Wilson, the Los Angeles Timos stated.

Judgo Wilson said that the land formelly conveyed to a Japanese American but actually bought by a Japanese alien, becomes the property of the state of California at the time of tho sale.

Passed 1920, the Alien Land Act bars aliens who arc incligible for American citizenship from owning land.

WRA BUDGET GETS SLASHED DURING NEW FISCAL YEAR The Committee on Appro- for the coming fiscal perpriation of the House of icd.

> Missouri's Reprosentative Cannon, chairman of the Appropriations Committee, submitted a report in explanation of the bill which contained proposed 1946 fiscal appropriations for war agencies, and included this statement regarding WRA:

"This is the last appropriation which will be reoutred for the WEA which is charged with the rossponsibility for the care of those persons of Japanese origin evacuated from the west coast in the winter of 1942. A considerable number, probably 18, 000 out of the total of 117,000 Japanese persons, originally under the jurisdiction of the War Relocation Authority, will be detained at Tule Lake center and turned over to Department of Justice authorities. They fall in two catagories -- those determined by investigation to be undesirable to remain in the United States, and those who have expressed a preference, to be returned to Japan. Of the remaining group, all but 53,000 have already been relocated outside the centers. The 53,000 will be relocated at the rate of six or seven thousand per month and such persons will have left the centers by the end of the calendar year of 1945. At . that point, the War Relocation Authority will have no further responsibility for the care and custody of these persons and during the remaining six months of the fiscal year will wind up its Jusiness affairs and be entirely out of business by June 30, 1946.
