RETURNING NISEI SOLDIERS TO BE AIDED BY NEW PLAN

LAKE GARDA, Italy--White officers of the 442nd American Infantry Regiment, disgusted with the discrimination against persons of Japanese ancestry along the U.S. West Coast, have organized their own replacement plan for the Japanese American veterans who are now returning to the homeland under the 85 point system, the Army Stars and Stripes reports.

Originated by Lieut. William Wolff of Evanston, Ill., the plan calls for a committee of three regimental officers who interview each Nisei soldier (Continued on Page 2)

CREW TEARS DOWN BUILDING 36-15

In line with the WRA's plan of closing the relocation centers, Building 36-15 is being torn down this week and its lumber will be eventually used for crating goods of resettling evacuees, Project Director Ralph P. Merritt announced.

This particular building has no lincolum and only a few partitions.

The project director stated that another building will be torn down later but that the second building will be one with several partitions.

The cost of tearing down these two buildings will be averaged and compared with the cost of new lumber.

SEEK OWNERS OF GOODS STORED AT BUDDHIST CHURCH ON MAIN ST.

Evacuee Property Officer David S. Bromley announced that removal of property from the Buddhist Church at 1427 Main Street, Seattle is necessary and requests all persons using the church for storage to contact him at once.

He also cautioned resettlers to make arrangements to have their personal property picked up at least one week before departure. Owners should accompany their belongings to the crating warehouse at mess hall 4 and remain there while it is being crated.

Form 156 must then be made out by owners in order that shipment can be made. Unless these forms are signed, property cannot be shipped.

Immediately after crated property is moved from the crating warehouse to mess hall 2, each owner should go there and execute the necessary papers.

Bromley further stated that property now in WRA warehouses in Los Angeles and other cities cannot be delivered by the government to points less than 25 miles from such ware-

MAKING FIRECRACKERS AGAINST STATE LAW

An announcement from the Fire and Police Department reports that children have been seen around the blocks playing with firecrackers made from matches.

As the use of firecrackers is against the WRA parents are warned to keep their children from playing with them.

The use of these homemade "firecrackers" is dangerous to the safety of the center residents and may cause a fire within the center.

In addition, there is a great shortage of matches. Evacuees relocating to such points must make their own arrangements for transportation of their goods.

JUDGE WILSON VOIDS 'DUMMY' LAND SALES

LOS ANGELES—So-called "dummy" land sales are void according to a ruling handed down this week by Superior Judge Emmet H. Wilson, the Los Angeles Times stated.

Judge Wilson said that the land formally conveyed to a Japanese American but actually bought by a Japanese alien, becomes the property of the state of California at the time of the sale.

Passed 1920, the Alien Land Act bars aliens who are ineligible for American citizenship from owning land.

heading home and who will furnish the soldiers the names of men already contacted in America, who will help the Nisei soldier find a place in his chosen industry or profession.

The veteran will also be given references from company, battalion, and regimental commanders attesting his membership in one of the most decorated outfits of the U.S. Army.

Every officer in the regiment was polled for names of people in his hometown who might be willing to help the Nisei.

When a soldier with more than 85 points is ready to return to the United States, he is given an interview and asked where he would like to settle and what he would like to do. Then the board will give him a reference in that area and for that industry.

About 250 Nisei soldiers recently returned to the United States with this aid, the Stars and Stripes said.

BOOK ON POSTON CENTER WRITTEN BY NAVY MAN

"The Governing Of Men", a book dealing with the Japanese in the Poston, Ariz., Relocation Center, and authored by Lieut. Comdr. Alexander H. Leighton, USNR Medical Corps, has just been published by the Princeton University Press and is now available for \$3.75.

Commander Leighton, a psychiatrist and anthropologist, tells of the dramatic story of the evacuees from the time of the Pearl Harbor attack to the present time--the evacuation, the organization of self-government, the strike, the conflicts among the internees themselves and within the administration.

The book contains 40 photographs and has 420 pages.

COURT ENJOINS ARMY FROM USING 'FORCE'

LOS ANGELES--Maj. Gen. J.L. Pratt, Western Defense commander was enjoined from using military force to prevent persons of Japanese ancestry from going anywhere they wish in the United States in a ruling by Federal Judge Pierson N. Hall, the New York PM Daily states.

The American Civil Liberties Union hailed the decision as "noteworthy and courageous."

WRA BUDGET GETS SLASHED

The Committee on Appropriation of the House of Representative has submitted to Congress a bill recommending a \$25,000,000 appropriation for the War Relocation Authority for the 1946 fiscal year, the WRA Office in Washington announced.

The amount represents a reduction of \$140,000 under the sum requested in budget estimates. The appropriation for fiscal year 1945 was \$37,500,000 for WRA, \$12,500,000 more than the sum recommended

DURING NEW FISCAL YEAR

for the coming fiscal period.

Missouri's Representative Cannon, chairman of the Appropriations Committee, submitted a report in explanation of the bill which contained proposed 1946 fiscal appropriations for war agencies, and included this statement regarding WRA:

"This is the last appropriation which will be required for the WRA which is charged with the responsibility for the care of those persons of Japanese origin evacuated from the west coast in the winter of 1942. A considerable number, probably 18,000 out of the total of 117,000 Japanese persons, originally under the jurisdiction of the War Relocation Authority, will be detained at Tule Lake center and turned over to Department of Justice authorities. They fall in two categories--those determined by investigation to be undesirable to remain in the United States, and those who have expressed a preference, to be returned to Japan. Of the remaining group, all but 53,000 have already been relocated outside the centers. The 53,000 will be relocated at the rate of six or seven thousand per month and such persons will have left the centers by the end of the calendar year of 1945. At that point, the War Relocation Authority will have no further responsibility for the care and custody of these persons and during the remaining six months of the fiscal year will wind up its business affairs and be entirely out of business by June 30, 1946.

TEAMSTERS' UNION ACCEPTS NISEI GI

SEATTLE -- Americans of Japanese ancestry who have proven their loyalty by service in the armed forces of the United States will be welcomed to work alongside members of the Teamsters' Union, Vice President Dave Beck of the International for 11 western states said this week, according to the San Francisco Chronicle.

MINNEAPOLIS JAPANESE OPENS NEW BEAUTY SHOP

CHICAGO--May Okamoto of the Ogden Hotel, Minneapolis, Minn., recently opened a Beauty Shop in Minneapolis. She is a former resident of the Heart Mountain Relocation Center.

May Okamoto, who came to Minneapolis in September of 1943, is the first Nisei to open a beauty shop in the Minnesota district. Because of the large Japanese American population in the Twin Cities, the relocation officer, James Hiner, Jr., predicts "May's Beauty Salon" will be a huge success.

ONTARIO, OREGON MAKES GREAT PROGRESS NOW

Returning to Salt Lake City after a ten days' tour of the intermountain area, Saburo Kido, National JACL president, commented on the great progress that the Ontario District of Oregon has made during the last three years.

Saburo Kido stated that in Hampa and Caldwell, Idaho, newcomers are not welcome. There are signs, "No Maps Allowed" throughout the area of Western Idaho but in Eastern Idaho the situation seems to be favorable.

The leading newspapers of Idaho have been fair and have helped to check any troublesome events.

U.S. SOLDIERS DISLIKE PERSECUTION OF NISEI

SAN FRANCISCO, June 30—American soldiers fighting in the Pacific fronts don't like the persecution of persons of Japanese ancestry in the United States, Joe E. Brown, famous screen star declared this week in this city, the Los Angeles Times announced.

The actor, who just returned from a 38,000 mile tour of the Pacific fronts declared that these soldiers think that these persecutions of the Nisei are "terrible".

He added, "They think it's horrible. I know. I've had a number of round-table discussions with them on that subject alone."

Joe E. Brown continued to explain that a loyal Japanese American was just as liable to be killed by his buddies as by the enemy since many Japanese enemy had been found dressed in American uniforms.
