EVACUEES ELIGIBLE TO SOCIAL SECURITY PROVISIONS

Evacuees in relocation and reception centers are eligible to the benefits of the Old Age and Survivors Insurance provisions of the Social Security Act, it was announced

through the Regional Office last week.

Local residents who are entitled to the benefits should make application at the Social Security Board, Federal Building, Los Angeles.

Many evacuees have recently become eligible for the benefits, according to the Board. Others who had been receiving payments prior to evacuation are no longer getting checks, for their addresses are unknown. These persons should communicate immediately with the Los Angeles office for their checks.

WAGES COMING

Approximately 1200 "P" and "S" rating workers have collected \$14,958.300 in June wages, according to the Fiscal department.

The balance of the June pay, as well as the May payments, is expected sometime this week. April checks distributed totaled \$8,683.41, with \$417.51 not claimed, and \$432.90 for the Idaho beet workers.

ASK HOUSING FOR ALTERATIONS

If you want alterations made in your living quarters, direct your requests to the housing department, said Arthur H. Miller, chief of housing and employment today. Many persons are reported cutting out their own doors.

Families residing in Block 28 now without permission are requested to move out immediately as special diet cases are being moved in.

NEW MATTRESSES

Replacement of flattened straw mattresses with freshly stuffed ticks is being conducted by the housing department crew. Residents are asked to turn in their old mattresses at the time they receive the new ones.

QUESTIONNAIRES DUE

National Student Relocation Questionnaires must be returned by Wednesday noon. High school graduates, college students and graduates desiring transfer to other colleges or who wish to continue their education by extension courses may apply for the forms at 1-9-4. Questionnaires received last week have already been sent to the Relocation committee in Berkeley.

SIGNED PERMITS NECESSARY FOR ALL VISITORS

Special permits signed by either Project Director Roy Nash or Assistant Director Ned Campbell are required of all non-Japanese persons entering or leaving the Manzanar Relocation Center, according to proclamation of Lt. Gen. J.L. DeWitt of the Western Defense Command and Fourth Army.

RECORD TO BE KEPT

Each permit must show the hour of entry and departure and the terms and conditions upon and the purpose for which it is granted. A complete record of all such permits will be kept and maintained at the center.

KITCHENS TO CLOSE

For general cleaning and repairing of the kitchens, beginning today with Kitchen 1, mess halls in numerical order will remain closed on consecutive days with the exception of Sundays.

On days that their kitchens are closed, people will eat in the two nearest mess halls.

RETURN ALL EMPTY POP BOTTLES

A camp-wide drive for empty pop bottles is being launched this week by the canteen as the serious mortgage of bottles is threatening the stoppage of all pop sales.

All residents are requested to collect empty bottles and turn them over to the leader of their respective block by Thursday morning.

Those residing in blocks without leaders are asked to leave the bottles by the men's latrines where they will be picked up by a truck.

Beginning Thursday, a two-cent deposit must be paid on each bottle if it is taken out of the canteen. A 60-cent deposit will be charged on a case.

On Friday, 150 pairs of shoes were shipped to this firm through the center's department store. This service was made possible through E. C. Poole, community enterprise superintendent and Matsusaburo Shiozaki, store manager.

Dry cleaning rates have also been lowered through efforts of the enterprise officials.

## PERMIT REQUIRED

Persons having personal property stored with the Federal Reserve Bank warehouses and if such has been purchased on installment plan or subject to chattel mortgage are requested to contact Masao Kadomatsu at 1-9-2.

They are advised to secure a written consent of the seller or mortgagee in moving such property out of the county, otherwise they will lose equity in the property and may even be subject to civil action.
