from George Yester typewrited. Still he working the ni-
ght shift, 7 to 7 seven days a week in the Army hospital
with perfect his health, I will send him a card next w'k.

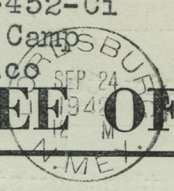
You say the view, yes! great! I get up early in the mor-
