## Arizona Coffers Increased By\$26,233.00

The State of Arizona has collected \$26,233 by virtue of the fact that the Gila River Cooperative Enterprises, Inc., is in existence at Rivers. This fact was brought out by an inconspicuous news item on the last page of one of the Phoenix nowspaper, stating that \$26,233 in sales and luxury taxes were paid by the Co-op for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1943.

## STUDENT TRAINE E COURSE IN CO-OP

Recently, a student trainee program was instituted in the Gila Co-op Enterprises for the Rivers High Schools Under this set-up, student trainees are placed in the various departments of the Coop and each trainee puts in a required number of hours of work toward his high school credit. The requirement is 15 hours work in the Co-op and of study in 2 hours one of the Co-op Study Groups, making a total of 17 hours por student por wook. When the patronage accounting section of the Co-op completed issuing some 700 checks representing patronage refund payments to the segregants, some interesting figures were dis-closed. The highest individual check was written for \$165.48 and went to a member in Butte Community. There were several other sichecks, from to \$127.00 but zeable \$80.00 to the greatest number fell in the range \$10.00 to \$35.00. The smallest check was for \$.25.

Al most a parallel to the establishment of the Rochdale Store by the 28 Rochdale Pioneers in 1844, 26 men and women, all southern share croppers, started a co-op store on May 18, 1943 in Spruce Those Pine, Alabama. cooperators saved up enough until they had a combined capital of \$205. And, in keep-ing with one of the fundamental principlos laid down by the Rochdalo Pionocra, - that there be no racial, religious, or political discrimination, - two of the directors of this new organization aro Nogrocs.

It is going to be an interesting venture to watch. If the Rechdale Principles and Practices are adhered to, there is no reason why this co-op store should not develop into a large, modern consumer co-op store. Our hats off to the 26 Pieneers!
