The primary purpose of the Co-op is service, - to furnish the residents various needs insofar as those needs can be reasonably supplied. This is wartime and while there are many things we would like to have, we cannot help but face the fact that as every day goes by, civilian goods aro getting more and more scarco. Not only scarco but may items have disappoired completely from the market.

The general manager and the merchandising committee of the Co-op are exerting evory eftimes fort at all to got whatever is available for the community. It is obvious, however, that your canteens cannot stock their shelves with every item under the sun, so to speak. In cases where special articles are desired, these are turned over to the Shopping Service Department.

As to pricing, the policy is to price merchandise at prevailing market prices, and lower whenever conditions permit. If a comparison is made, you will find that prices here are generally lower than on the outside. The main point to bear in mind is that the difference between sales and the cost of doing business,which is called savings, comes back to the form of pa you in patronage This is one refunds. of the basic Rochdale Principles, under which all sound cooperatives operate.
