

TRANSFEREES' KILLING FROST DUE SOON; SPECIAL MAIL FARM CROPS ENDANGERED SERVICE SET

For the convenience of departing residents to Tule Lake, the evacuee staff of the Topaz post office will accommodate them with last minute deliveries.

The first group of transferees, who leave the center Sunday, will receive their mail and packages until 5 PM Saturday.

The second and third train groups will get mail service until the morning of their departure.

All incoming mail addressed to transferees received after their departure to Tule Lake will be forwarded to them as soon as the post office is told of their new addresses.

TRANSFEREE MEETINGS: To discuss arrangements made for freight and checkable baggage, the information consultants will conduct conferences with the first group of transferees in the designated blocks tomorrow from 8:30 AM, it was revealed.

With the normal killing frost date being about September 19 at Topaz, the agriculture department is preparing to harvest tender crops at a moment's notice, according to George McCollm, associate agronomist. Plans are now made to mobilize a large center crew at short notice to harvest approximately 63 acres of tomatoes, eggplants, cantaloupes, and peppers.

BOND DRIVE OPENS HERE

With the WRA share for the third war loan drive, which opened on September 9, established at \$120,000, Topaz's quota for its appointed personnel is in excess of \$10,500, it was revealed today by Gilbert L. Niesse, general drive chairman.

The sum represents 30 per cent of the gross September payroll, in conformity with the recommendation that all employees of government agencies participate in this way during the national campaign, which ends October 2.

Section heads will contact their workers today to pledge them for bond purchases, according to Niesse.

Following is a brief report of the crops subject to frost damage:

EGGPLANT: 14,000 plants; first picking of fine quality eggplants next week; attempts will be made to protect the plants from frost.

TOMATOES: 35 acres. Approximately 30 tons of matured tomatoes now on the vines. Tomato picking will start today.

CANTALOUPE: Although this crop has been progressing well, a full crop will not be picked unless frost dates are later than normal.

651 ENROLL IN GRADE SCHOOLS

Approximately 651 pupils are attending the Desert View and Mountain View elementary schools since the new term opened Monday, according to Miss Wanda Robertson, principal.

Included among the students are more than 60 who will leave for Tule Lake.

Kenneth Harkness, superintendent of education at Tule Lake, asked that all transferee students attend classes in Topaz as long as possible. Attendance records and past school reports will be sent to the schools at Tule Lake.

The change in command, subject of persistent ru-

mors for weeks, came in this terse 3-sentence statement:

"The War Department has announced the relief of Lieut. General John L. DeWitt as commanding general of the Western Defense Command and Fourth Army, effective on or about Sept. 15. Gen. DeWitt has been assigned as commandant of the Army and Navy Staff College in Washington, DC.

"Lieut. General Delos C. Emmons has been assigned to and will assume command effective upon the relief of General DeWitt."

During the last 30 days, the Topaz relocation center has received 4 car-loads of vegetables from the Tule Lake project, it was reported today by Brandon Watson, chief project steward.

Included among the produce received from the California center are nappa, turnip, potatoes, and carrots.

In every instance the vegetables were packed well and were delivered in excellent condition, according to Watson.

Other sources which provide vegetables for center consumption are the quartermaster market center in Salt Lake City and the Topaz farm, it was indicated.


NEW HOURS SET BY JAPANESE LIBRARY
