Since its establishment 3 NEW SERVICE weeks ago, the carrier service of the Transportation Division PROVIDES DAILY has developed into one of the busiest organizations in Topaz.

TRANSPORTATION At its office in Administration Building 1, the staff, under Art Eaton, is on the job from 9 AM to 10 PM daily, arranging free transportation accomodations for residents, officials, teachers, visiting soldiers and administrative personnel traveling between Topaz and neighboring communities.

Requests for this service are being treated on the basis of established priorities, which are: 1, Medical and dental attention outside of the Project; 2. Appointive personnel, government officials and residents going to or coming from the Delta train depot; 3. Official business outside the Project; 4. Legitimate private business, verified in writing by a division chief; and 5. Shopping, verified as essential by a division chief.

The service has 6 passenger cars and 2 trucks. Under foreman Min Mayeda, the crew has 16 drivers including one girl, Miss Yuki Minamoto. Sam Isono and Warren Hayashi head the dispatching staff.

EMPLOYMENT FIGURES SHOW

3,698 residents were employed by the WRA in the City last month, according to information released by the Employment Division. This figure is 294

INCREASE more than that of October. On November's pay list the \$19 per month classification included 365 male and 145 female workers; \$16--

2,285 male, 903 female; and \$12--1 male. 650 residents are now employed outside the Project, and 177, mostly agricultural workers, returned to offset the 87 who left last month.

All of the 330 applications for pe manent leaves filed here so far have been sent to the national WRA office at Washington, D.C. The number of temporary leaves issued totaled 722.

Unemployment figures show the registration of 210 males and 190 females for whom no suitable positions are available at present.
