Before coming to Manzanar, Dr. Goto served for a number of years as the head surgeon of the Los Angeles County Hospital, and there achieved a reputation as a brilliant surgeon.

At present, Drs. Mas Harada, Benjamin Kondo and Paul Yamauchi are on duty at the local hospital, with a fourth, Dr. John Teshima on a visit leave to Poston, Ariz.

## DRAFT REGISTRATION FOR NISEI YOUTHS, 18-19, BEGINS

Selective Service registration for all 18 and 19 year male residents of Topaz who have not yet been registered began this morning at the city hall, 1-9-E. Expected to be resumed tomorrow at 10 AM and completed by 1 PM, this compulsory registration is estimated to

affect about 250 residents in this age group, stated Bob Iki, head of the Community Government section.

Those in this age bracket include boys who have attained the minimum age on or since June 30, 1942.

In co-operation with the Millard County draft board, a group of prominent residents, who were duly sworn into the office of registrars in a brief ceremony yesterday afternoon, are conducting the enrollment.

Serving as chief registrar, Tsune Baba, chairman of the Community Council, appointed Toshimi Ogawa, Rev. K. Kumata, Vernon Ichisaka, Saiki Muneno, Sus Yamashita and Bob Iki as assistants.

## DUST - - -

The region's worst dust storm striking Topaz played havoc not only with all work in the open but caused cessation of work in the administration buildings late yesterday afternoon.
