## 103 RESIDENTS GET NON-WORK COMPENSATION

Out of 110 applications for unemployment compensation, 103 have been found eligible and most have received benefits up to December 31, 1942.

All those who are eligible for January benefits will receive what they are due early in February by applying to Miss Aya Shimizu at the Placement Office, Rec 4.

Persons who are found eligible for unemployment compensation are also eligible for clothing allowances.

Tomorrow is the last day on which applications for past benefits may be made, it was emphasized.
