WRA PROGRAM AFFECTED BY NEW ARMY POLICY--ERNST

"The entire War Relocation Authority program has been definitely affected by the War Department's new policy calling for the admittance of citizens of Japanese extraction into the U.S. Army," declared Project Director Charles F. Ernst in a statement made upon his return from the WRA conference of project directors in Denver, Colorado, January 28, 29 and 30.

"In the meantime, the local Project program will proceed as planned, as it is estimated that about 80 per cent of the residents here will continue to live in Topaz during 1943," he asserted.

アメリカインディアンの話
