DELTA-TOPAZ ROAD TO GET HARD SURFACE

Hard surfacing of the entire 16 mile road linking Delta with Topaz was assigned Saturday to the W.W. Clyde company, Springfield contractors, it was stated in an article appearing in the Salt Lake Tribune, February 1.

A bituminous surface is to be laid on 11.6 miles between Sutherland and the City, the five-mile link between Delta and Sutherland already having been surfaced.

The job is expected to be started within 10 days, with the contract providing for completion within 125 working days.
