

DELTA-TOPAZ ROAD TO GET HARD SURFACE

Hard surfacing of the entire 16 mile road linking Delta with Topaz was assigned Saturday to the W.W.Clyde company, Springfield contractors, it was stated in an article appearing in the Salt Lake Tribune, February 1.

A bituminous surface is to be laid on 11.6 miles between Sutherland and the City, the five-mile link between Delta and Sutherland already having been surfaced.

The job is expected to be started within 10 days, with the contract providing for completion within 125 working days.

HISTORY OF UTAH

アメリカ・インディアンが米大陸の發生種族でなく、アジア大陸から渡來して來たものであるといふことは、大体明らかである。しかし、學者の意見も概ね一致してゐる。最も有力な説によると、彼らの祖先は約一萬數千年前、北極海峡(アラスカ、シベリア間)を渡り、或いはアリエ

シモン群島を飛石傳、その前の第三紀鮮新世時代に人間と呼ぶには余りにも縁遠い。しかし、猿公よりは幾らかマシな、といふ格好の動物が出現した。それは、約五、六萬年、二百萬年といふ途方もない大昔(といふも地球が出来たのは、千億年の五、十億年といふ、永久的過ぎた。それだから、水から考へると、此の間のことかも知れない)のことである。その頃の人間は、チンパンジー位の智慧しか持ち合さなかつた。それが、段々進歩して、何時の間にか武器、道具、石を使ふ様になつた。水を原始石器時代のといふ。

處が、その石の使用が更に進歩發達して、舊石器時代に移る。この時代は、十萬年乃至百五十萬年つづく。これは、明らかに氷河時代である。氷河時代といつても、つと氷に閉ざされてゐたわけでは、なく、出たり引つたりを、十三回も繰り返すのである。
