### Site to be at Block 22

Plans have been made to establish another Canteen on the south-east corner of Block 22, the original bu-

siness shop area for the Center, disclosed Hideo Muto, general manager of the Rohwer Cooperative Enterprises. The Canteen will open as soon as the store building, which will be Barrack 1 in Block 22, is located in Block 22.

According to Kenneth Cole, construction engineer, the barrack has already been fixed for moving and will be transferred sometime this month.

"Canteen #2 will stock the same merchandises as carried in Canteen #1, including bakery goods, cigarettes, drugs, hardware supplies, groceries, periodicals, stationery and Oriental food and goods. The Mail Order department in Block 10 will be transferred to the new store," reported Muto.

Establishment of service departments including watch and radio repair shops is also being planned, if space is available in the new store building.

The resolution to open a new Canteen was passed by the Co-op Board of Directors two months ago and approved by Project Director Ray D. Johnston.

oblivious to all about her. Turning back I sat down beside her and spoke to her reassuringly. Not understanding English she drew away in fear and suspicion. Her little girl, less than two years old, was pulling at her mother's skirt for attention, but the mother seemed completely unconscious of her presence. After staring at me for a moment, the girl sobs gradually ceased and climbing up the steps to where I was sitting on the wide cement bannisters she dropped down with complete confidence beside me and snuggled her baby head upon

my lap. As I gently stroked her hair. I could see through my tears that she had fallen asleep.

Then the miracle happened! In a few moments I felt the mother creep close to my side and leaning her head against my shoulder she sobbed gently as if in relief, and then her little brown hand crept up over my lap and came to rest on top of my hand on top of her baby's head. And so we sat for a long, long time in complete silence--two mothers with no basis of understanding either in language or in common ex-

Many, many people of goodwill and understanding on the outside are standing by to extend to you the hand of friendship and goodwill.

As I leave the camp, it is with a feeling of regret and a longing to know you better. Perhaps some day I shall return again, or better still, be able to visit you in your own homes on the outside.
