Center Schools Finance Three Jeeps

Three Jeeps costing \$3505.95 were contributed to the United States armed forces by the schools at the Rohwer relocation center, as they closed their first Center-wide War Bond and Stamp drive on Dec. 5.

Through the cooperation of merchants and businessmen at McGehee, arrangements have been made for special bus transportation from the Center to McGehee for Christmas shopping by Center residents.

Two trips per day, one in the morning from 8 to 11:30 a.m. and one in the afternoon from 1 to 5 p.m., will be made on Dec. 13, 14, 15, 16, 17 and 20. The bus will accommodate 33 persons per trip, making it a total of 12 persons per block going shopping this year. Details are being worked out by the block managers and Councilmen and will be announced to the residents. Bus fare will be 55¢ round trip.

All Center residents were informed that since no other shopping passes will be issued, all Christmas shopping must be done during this period. As there may be some shortage of merchandises this year, residents are asked to conduct themselves properly and shop individually or in as small a group as possible, according to Project Director Ray D. Johnston. No liquor will be allowed into the Center.

With all the students participating as bond and stamp saleswomen and salesmen, \$2537.20 was sold to the administrative personnel and \$968.75 to the evacuees. 53% of the high school students now possess War Stamp books.

With "Jeep or Bust" as the slogan, the drive was highlighted by bond rallies and various contests offering awards to those selling the most bonds and stamps.

Once again the residents of the Center pause to pay their tribute to the gallant swampers, lumberjacks, coalmen, and the garbage men. True, this paper has already acknowledged some of these valiant workers, but we, as the residents, cannot express our gratitude sufficiently....

Through days of bitter bleakness and driving winds, until when even the children of nature beg in to feel the sharpness and the cruelty of the cold, the undermanned crew continues to work....work for the Center....

To most of us, the sound of swampers, the sight of coalmen, make us think them as the "lower crust" of society. They, who do the backbreaking works of the Center, they, who expose themselves to the dirtiness and discomforts of "common laborers" have been looked down as the "lower crust" of our society....

Yes, some of them do get \$19, the top salary of the Center, but what is this? This meager difference can hardly begin to cover the wear and tear of their respective jobs; it cannot make up for the filth and strenuity that is their job.

The National Conference of Japanese Christian Leaders will be held Dec. 16-17 in Denver, Colo., to discuss the future of Japanese churches and their postwar problems.

Rohwer center will be represented by the Rev. J. K. Fukushima, president of the local Ministers' council, and the Rev. K.T. Shirashi, Japanese secretary, who left yesterday for Denver, and the Rev. K. H. Sakane, English secretary, who will be leaving Monday. They are expected back on Dec. 22.

"Why did a moron take a bucket of water to his employer?"

"Because he was ready to get fired!!!"

But now, getting away from the corn...When I picked up a recent issue of the Poston Chronicle, my eyes were stopped by the news of the barrack fire. Beyond the headline, the article went on to relate the sad story of the two barracks that were burnt and of the evacuees that were involved. According to the article, one of the barracks was razed to the foundation in a matter of minutes...so fast that not a personal effect of the evacuees was removed. Very sad indeed...the properties lost were perhaps the lifelong accumulation of the evacuees. Can't you imagine these people just standing helplessly, seeing their cherished belongings and lifelong treasures go up in smokes? These pre-war properties condensed into small bundles by evacuation...containing only those articles deemed important...now being reduced to ashes... To those people, the world may seem dark, desolate, and maybe wicked...it is a pity...

To me the significance of the story was not only because it concerned a family I knew, but the same thing can and will happen here if we are not careful. That incident was something remote way out in Arizona, but the dreadful part is it may be repeated here. With the cold weather, we are apt to overheat our stoves or by various other means of carelessness, a fire may be started. Our oil-paper covered barracks are potent

Starting off the second round of the Rohwer light-weight league will see the revamped Broncos meeting the twice beaten Blue Devils this afternoon, starting at 2 o'clock on the Senior high school gridiron.

Today's game is a crucial one for the injury riddled Broncos, for they must win today in order to keep pace with the undefeated and untied Los Angeles Joker Y's.

As for the fighting Blue Devils, they will go out there this afternoon to pull an upset and to get revenge for the 6-0 setback handed to them by the same Broncos.
