Nisei To Notify Washington

In a teletype recently received from Dillon S. Myer, WRA Director, all Nisei men of military age were asked to send the name, number, and address of their local Selective Service Boards to the Relocation Planning Division, War Relocation Authority, Barr Building, Washington, D. C.

Myer explained that induction will be a gradual process, but that this information was essential in order that the record of each individual might be brought up to date at once. Myer also requested that men of military age in the

relocation centers be reminded of the importance of keeping their Selective Service Boards notified of all changes of address.

He said that men who could not be located and notified to appear for pre-induction physical examinations when their order numbers appeared would be reported as delinquent and would be subject to severe penalties under the Selective Service Act.

Nisei in this group were advised to notify Washington directly, as soon as possible, although no definite deadline has been announced as yet.

Murai, Noted Agriculturist, To Deliver Lectures Here

Rohwer residents will be treated to rare and most interesting talks in the coming weeks. Koh Hibutsu Murai of Lincoln, Neb. will soon visit the Center for a period of six weeks at which time he will deliver lectures on Practical Field agriculture.

Hailing from Los Angeles, Murai, better known as Hibutsu, has an impressive record behind him. A graduate from the Tokyo College of Science, for three years he was the adviser in engineering for the Swiss settlement in Mexico.

Pre-enrollment for these lectures will be taken this week at various block offices, starting tomorrow. His visit is jointly sponsored by the Agriculture division, and the Adult education department, and approved by the Community council.

Murai has delivered lectures on agriculture in several states. At present, he is publisher and editor of the INDUSTRIAL DAILY NEWS OF AMERICA. He is also author of "Encyclopedia of Agriculture" published in Japanese.

ARMY TRUCKS ON THEIR WAY

Project Director Ray D. Johnston and H. F. Naff, equipment maintenance supervisor, returned to the Center Saturday night, after a 11-day trip which took them to nine army camps in Texas, Louisiana and Oklahoma. They made the trip, accompanied by representatives from Jerome, to inspect and select surplus vehicles for WRA use, at the request of the War Department.

A total of 51 vehicles which included sedans, cargoes, trucks, stakes and dump trucks were selected, and these will be divided between Rohwer and Jerome. Arrangements are being planned at present for the delivery of these properties, Naff said.

Goods Arrive From Overseas

Words were received through the WRA office that several items of Japanese goods have been received by the Center. These were sent by the Japanese Red Cross to be distributed to the Japanese nationals.

The items received to date are: 325 barrels of shoyu sauce; 13 barrels of miso; and 1 case of drugs. 40 cases of Green Tea and 1 case of books are also being shipped.

These articles arrived recently on the M.S. Gripsholm, and distribution of them will be decided by the Community council.

Many Nisei Soldiers Awarded The Order of the Purple Heart

Information has been received by the War Relocation Authority that 59 members of the 100th Infantry Battalion recently were awarded the Order of the Purple Heart. Fifty-eight of them are Nisei from Hawaii and the other a Caucasian lieutenant from Kansas.

They received the decoration, by order of their Division Commander, for wounds received in the fighting in Italy on November 28, 29 and 30.

The Purple Heart is the oldest military decoration of the United States, the order having been established by Gen. George Washington during the Revolutionary War and is awarded for wounds received in action before the enemy.

Oshima will be succeeded by Kaz Fukuya as sports editor.

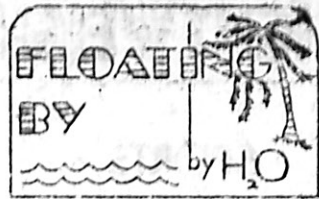
