All draft registrants leaving the Center should report his new address immediately, upon arrival to his destination, to both his original California Draft board and to Local Draft Board No. 1, Desha County, McGehee, Ark., in order to protect himself of becoming a delinquent.

Paralysis Drive Results Given

Results of the March of Dimes drive which took in a total amount of \$480.66 toward the Infantile Paralysis fund were released yesterday.

This sum was contributed from all the blocks, various organizations, schools and the appointed personnel as follows: Center residents, \$231.30; schools, \$124.92; appointed personnel, \$109.44; and RFGC, \$15.

Edwin Bethune, personnel technician, was the chairman of the drive for the appointed personnel; Frank Dete, chairman of the Block managers, headed the Center collection.

Checks Delay Reasons Given

Assistant Project Director F. R. Mangham recently stated that Center residents should not write to the Treasury Disbursement office in St. Louis, Mo., about their clothing allowance and pay checks' delay.

"All checks are subject to some delay since all pay check and clothing allowance accounts are sent in on different time schedules," he said.

Army to Offer Specialized Training Program to Niseis

A special Army training program is being offered to the boys between the ages of 17-22, who are high school graduates.

This Army Specialized Training Program is to provide technicians and specialists for the army. Those selected for this

program will study at government expense, at colleges and universities in fields determined by their qualifications. They will be soldiers on active duty, in uniform, under military discipline and on regular army pay.

Those desiring this training must first pass a qualifying test. The qualifying test for this center will be administered on March 15, in Block 35. The hour will be announced later.

This test will be administered only to boys who: are citizen of U.S.; will be 17-22 inclusive on July 1, 1944; high school graduates who are still in Center; are now in school, who will graduate by July 1, 1944; are physically qualified. Additional qualifications are: be morally and physically qualified; evidence potential leadership qualification, including appearance; and possess good scholarship record.

All interested young men in this test are to report to Opal Albright in 35-12-C before noon, today. Also, make arrangements with Miss Albright for an appointment for a physical check-up.

Poultry Farm Completed

The Poultry Farm, which is located on the north side of the hospital and adjoining the present hog ranch, was completed yesterday, according to Tom Makino, resident architect.

This farm is 20' x 100' and is expected to upkeep some 20,000 fowls annually. Several thousand chickens are already here and are housed temporarily in one of the warehouses. All breeding equipments have already been brought and delivered, and await installation.

REVENUE MAN AIDS TAXPAYERS

Deputy Herren Peacock will be in the Center on Feb. 22 and 23 to aid evacuees fill out their income tax blanks.

Taxpayers, when seeing Peacock, must have the following information at hand; form W-2 or V-2 furnished you by your employer showing wages received and tax withheld; form 1125 sent you by the Collector of Internal Revenue with the blank forms for 1943 showing tax reported and amount paid for 1942; if you filed a Declaration of Estimated Tax during 1943, a copy of such declaration, Form 1040-ES; or the Taxpayers Work Sheet used in preparing it; all members of the armed forces and any other taxpayers who do not have item 2 above should have with them a copy of the 1942 tax return and a record of the exact amount of tax paid thereon; and an accurate record of all other income besides wages received in 1943.

Mrs. Sada Murayama of Stevens Hotel Here For Recruitment

Mrs. Sada Murayama is here recruiting workers for the Stevens Hotel in Chicago, Ill. Opportunities are open for young girls and older women to work as maids.

At the present, only half of the hotel is open because of the lack of employees. With 3000 rooms, the hotel is the largest in the world. A whole section has been converted into a dormitory for girls only. Two persons will share one room which is furnished with twin beds and a private bath. Two rooms will be used as recreation and guest room. Mrs. Murayama from Jerome and Mrs. Yamamoto will act as guardians and advise them on any problems they may have.

The wage will be \$83 a month, eight hours a day, for six days a week. For overtime, they will be paid 60% an hour. Room and board will be \$1 a day, with taxes and social security totaling \$5.61. This is a seasonal leave.
