Blinded Nisei Soldier Writes

Pfc. Yoshinao Omiya, Hawaiian Nisei member of the 100th Battalion who was blinded in the Italian campaign, sent here the following letter on Mar. 6. Sub-titled "An American hero loses his sight at the crossing of the Volturno," a full-page picture of Pfc. Omiya appeared in the LIFE magazine of Feb. 7, telling how he had one eye blown out and the other damaged when a land mine exploded. Confined formerly at an army hospital in Memphis, Tenn., Pfc. Omiya is now at Ward 8B, VF General Hospital, Phoenixville, Pa.

The letter, addressed to the War Relocation Authority, follows:

Dear Sir:

Here is my long overdue answer, reply to your letter of some time ago. Received many fan letters and packages and didn't know how to go about it in answering all my letters and thanking those who sent me things. Finally got some one to read these letters while I take down a few short notes in Braille as reference. I just learned the simple Braille so takes a little time.

Here in VF, we are getting around by ourselves. There are over 30 blind patients here and most of us go to the mess hall to eat. Wherever we go, we take our old faithful cane along with us which act as our seeing eye. Many are taking handicraft work and I will be joining them shortly when I get through answering my letters. So long now.

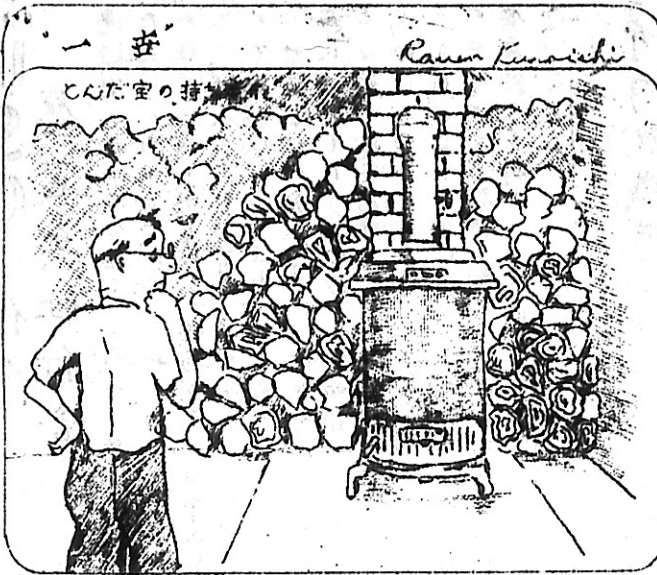
