CASUALTY: CALVIN SAITO DIES IN ITALY

A Marine Corps Lieutenant, veteran of 12 months in the South Pacific, was responsible for the publication of a letter describing the death in action of Pfc. Calvin Saito in the Aug. 4 issue of the Belmont (Mass.) Citizen.

The letter addressed to his father, Kiichi Saito residing in Belmont was written by another son, George, serving in Italy. Calvin, a radioman, died saving his fellow soldiers on the Italian front.

The letter read in part;

"Dad, this is no time to be preaching to you, but I have something on my chest which I want you to hear. In spite of Cal's supreme sacrifice, don't let anyone tell you that he was foolish or made a mistake to volunteer. Of what I've seen in my travels on our mission we've done the right thing in spite of what has happened in the past. America is a damn good country and don't let anyone tell you otherwise."

The deceased is the brother of Kaz Saito of Chicago, formerly of Rohwer, whose wife and child reside in Block 14. Kaz organized the Rohwer USO.

ONCE OVER AS by Bean Takeda

CHARLESTON, W. Va.—Readers want to know who the two doctors at the Charleston General hospital are and where they are from. Dr. George Miyakawa, who heads the traumatic (bone fracture department), hails from Sacramento, Dr. George H. Tsunekawa, who works in general surgery, is from Los Angeles. Neither has been in a relocation center, since both were away from the west coast at the time of evacuation. Dr. Miyakawa is a boyhood friend of Lt. Norman Kobayashi, formerly of Rohwer and now overseas with the 442nd. **TRIMMINGS**

One of the much-lamented casualties of the war is the fifty-cent haircut. You have to pay as much for a haircut now as you formerly did for a shave and a haircut. The price here is 65 cents. In Cleveland it used to be 75, has now been upped to 85. All it has really done, however, is to knock a dime off the tip, since customers generally leave a dollar bill anyway. **SCOTCH**

Which makes me shudder. I must be a frugal soul. I can't see paying a dollar for a haircut, unless they throw in a shampoo, shoe-shine, and a pants press along with it. I keep thinking of the two-bit trims I used to get in Rohwer. Along the Atlantic seaboard, especially around the shipyards, the barbers get a dollar straight for a haircut. At that rate, a fellow could own a couple of shops and retire after five years.

DISCRETION

There is a Chinese barber in Cleveland's Chinatown, which is a little affair of only a block long. Last time I was by there, two nisei war workers were offering five bucks to any nisei who would walk in there for a shave. There were no takers. I didn't take it, because I'd just shaved that morning. **Be-**
