Report of one of the important business of the 10th regular meeting of the Community Council held on Nov. 27, 1944 follows:

Shohei Fujino, chosen by the voting members of the Council has agreed to accept the position.

Boxes for use of lumberjacks will arrive within a short time.

Mr. Hiramoto of the Farm Committee reported the amount of harvest for the months of September and October as \$3921.84 and

\$257.61, respectively. Grand total for October (up to Oct. 31) amounted to \$450.45.

The revised form of food regulation, effective since July 1, requires that all the food stuff used even at the hospital and school must be paid out of our appropriated account which is 45¢ a day. All the food given for any organization or individual party is also deducted from this allotment.

Regulations of feeding the giving out of food-stuff for parties or any other occasions are now under consideration.

ONCE OVERS BY BEAN TAKEDA

One of the recent issues of "Yank," the Army newspaper, carried a fine account of the now-famous Battle of Belvedere in Italy, in which the 100th and the 442nd did themselves proud. That was the battle in which the 442nd received its baptism of fire. The WPA liked the article so much that it had reprints made of it.

It has been repeatedly stated that we civilians should be very careful of what we write to the soldiers overseas. A recent incident should serve to emphasize that point more clearly.

A local girl relocated to Chicago and went on a merry spree with some of her friends. She went to a chop suey dinner, a show, and a night of dancing in a nightclub. All this she related to a couple of her soldier friends at the front.

Back came a bitter, pointed answer. The boys didn't mind her having her good time, but they did mind her telling them about it. They had been living in mud for weeks, sleepin in water-filled fox holes, eating nothing but K rations. They hadn't eaten a hot meal in so long that they couldn't remember the last time.

A little common sense would tell us what to write and what not to write. We civilians have a tremendous responsibility in that respect.

SHELBY TOPIC OF YBA SERMON EVACUEE PROPERTY

The regular YBA service will be held at Blk. 35 at 10:15 a.m. with Fusako Matsui as chairman. The Rev. Kouichi will continue his sermon on his recent trip to Camp Shelby.

An evacuee who wishes to arrange for shipment of personal property must request such shipment by filling out Form WRA-156,

signing it and having the signature witnessed. Complete information should be given on the form.

Evacuees are entitled to free shipment of their household or personal effects from the original point of storage to a center or a point of relocation or, if they already have them in a center, to a point of relocation from the center. Evacuees wishing to have personal property shipped from a center to the point of relocation should make their requests to the Project Director of the project from which they moved.

The WRA will furnish help to the evacuee to get information on transportation costs when the evacuee wishes to have a private company ship his property. Requests for such help should be made on Form WRA-153.

In the matter of shipping commercial property, the Property Office will help the evacuee arrange for shipment to any point he desires but the cost of shipment, including packing, crating, loading, etc. must be paid by the evacuee.

However, the WRA will pay for shipment to points of relocation tools and equipment of an evacuee's trade, business or profession, including farm machinery and equipment sufficient for a family-sized venture (but not over 5000 pounds shipping weight per family) if the Relocation Officer in the community in which the evacuee relocates or intends to relocate will certify that the use of such tools, equipment or fixture is necessary to the evacuee's successful relocation and that they cannot be replaced locally at the time because of wartime shortages.

All shipments must be made by freight unless the items are difficult to send safely by freight because of high value or small size. Furthermore if the Project Director or Relocation Officer certifies on Form WRA-156 that

(Continued from Page 3) express shipment is necessary in the interest of the relocation program, commercial goods may be sent by express. Express shipments at government expense may not exceed 500 pounds shipping weight.

Evacuees should consult with and ask the advice of the Property Office in all matters pertaining to shipment of all types of goods, sale of all types of property or in matters involving rentals, leases, taxes or disputes arising from contracts.

The Property Office, of which there is one on every project has been established for the purpose of aiding the evacuees. While its functions necessarily are limited, it can be of help to the evacuee in solving many types of individual problems. The evacuee is welcome at the Property Office and should avail himself of the services offered.
