The year was 1939, and the place was little Tokio in Los Angeles. He was just out of the University of California, in nearby Westwood, where he had made a fine record as a student and as a promising officer in the Reserve Officers Training Corps.

He and I used to have many a discussion on the future of the Nisei. The Iwaki drugstore fountain, in the heart of Little Tokio, was the popular meeting place for the Nisei. It was there that we could perch ourselves on the seats and over a cherry coke, or a cup of black coffee, talk over the affairs of the Nisei and of the world.

Our informal chinfests rarely lasted over an hour or so, because we generally got together at lunchtime or at customary coffee-and donut intermission at a few o'clock. But they were interesting sessions, because he was an interesting young man.

Came the war and evacuation, and he was sent to the Pomona Assembly Center and I to Santa Anita. We corresponded once or twice, but they were feeble attempts. And when he went to Heart Mountain and I came to those Arkansas marshes, we lost complete track of one another.

Then, early this year a soldier from Camp Shelby chanced to tell me that my confidante was at the Mississippi cantonment... He was a lieutenant now and doing nicely. I immediately sat down and wrote him a long, nostalgic letter, reminiscing about our coke and coffee days.

Back came an answer in a couple of weeks, but it wasn't a letter. It was an announcement of his marriage. It seems that, on his furlough, he had hastened back to Heart Mountain and taken a bride after a brief, whirlwind courtship. He was now getting ready to embark for overseas.

I didn't hear from him (Continued on Page 4)

PLAN OPENING OF PITTSBURGH WRA OFFICE, STATES CULLUM

Pittsburgh, Pa.—On the recommendation of Council of Churches of Allegheny County, steps are being taken to open a WRA office in the city of Pittsburgh in the heart of the "Arsenal of Democracy," Robert M. Cullum, Great Lakes area supervisor, announced last month.

RFCC TO HAVE CHAFLAIN AKI

The executive committee of the Council last week unanimously endorsed the program to relocate Japanese Americans and announced its action publicly in the three daily metropolitan papers. Prominent, favorable publicity was given to the story on the front pages of the papers.

Steps are now being taken by the Council to form a citizens resettlement committee of prominent residents in all walks of life to assist the WRA in obtaining employment and housing for the evacuees.

fied advertisement in the papers show a great need for men as laborers in the steel mills, as accountants, cooks, auto-mechanics, machine operators, bakery workers, domestics, as professional people radio service men, stock clerks, produce workers, and others. Ads for women also are endless calling for such artisans as bookkeepers, beauticians, bakery workers, commercial artists, domestics, clerks, cooks, dental assistants, factory workers, vegetable trimmers, and others.

Many of these jobs will undoubtedly be opened up for evacuees as soon as a permanent WRA official is appointed and an office is established, Cullum said. He added he expected to open such an office in a few days.

More detailed facts about the Western Pennsylvania district will be gathered together into pamphlets for distribution.

after that. But last August, while I was in Charleston (West Va.) on my three-month jaunt thru the eastern cities, I received word of his death in action in Italy.

He had died a hero's death. He was leading his platoon in an attack on a hill near Castellina, Italy, when they were pinned down by intense enemy fire. There was little cover for the advancing Mide troops, and the concentrated fire threatened the entire company.

The enemy's automatic weapons had to be knocked out. The young lieutenant said he and his men would do the job, and he led his platoon forward about 300 yards. Suddenly, a German automatic gun caught them by surprise on their flank, and my friend fell wounded.

But he refused first aid till his wounded men were treated and evacuated to safety. Meanwhile, he remained at his post and continued directing operations against the enemy. He was finally evacuated to a field hospital, but he died from his injuries and loss of blood. Doctors said he might have lived if he had permitted himself to be treated earlier and evacuated with the first group.

I sat down and wrote a long letter to his wife. I told her of the esteem with which her husband's friends had held him and of our grief at his death. And back came her answer, soft and touching but filled with unmistakable pride in her husband. She said,
