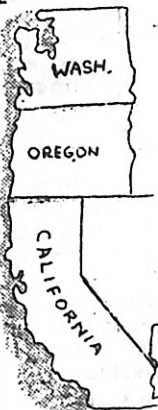
Christmas Celebration
