SIGN UP FOR SPECIAL CARS TELL OF DEEDS OF 442ND INF.

Need 15 More For May 30, 31

Ninety-nine requests have been received by the Relocation Office from persons to return to California on May 30 and 31, by special cars. Space is available for fifteen more persons.

If the center residents so desire, the Relocation Office will attempt to procure a Pullman, that will be routed in conjunction with the car leaving on May 30 or 31. Those who wish to take advantage of Pullman service and are eligible in accordance with WRA regulations should contact E. B. Brewster, Relocation Adviser (Leaves) at an early date.

Persons not eligible in accordance with WRA regulations but who wish to pay the difference may secure reservations if a sufficient number of people sign up to justify the use of a Pullman car.

It is important that those wishing Pullman space sign up immediately, as it is more difficult to complete arrangements for a special Pullman car than for coach cars. The cars scheduled to leave May 30 and 31 will take the same route as previous cars.

Members of the 442nd Infantry Regiment, who were spearheading the 5th Army advance which smashed the German Army in Northern Italy were reported to have killed 1,124 Germans, captured 331, and wounded several hundred, figures which do not tell the whole story because they do not include the dead buried or the wounded evacuated by the enemy.

At the same time the regiment swept up vast quantities of enemy material such as cars, motor-cycles, trucks, tanks, guns, field artillery pieces, mortars, machine guns and small arms of all types.

More than 90 per cent of the regiment won Combat Infantryman Badges for exemplary conduct under fire.

On January 12, 1945, additional testimony to the heroism of the 100th Infantry Battalion was offered when the Distinguished Service Cross was awarded to seven members of the unit, one award being made posthumously.

ONCE OVERS

The year is 2045, and the time is 6 o'clock in the evening. The season is late spring. The locale is Desha county, Arkansas.

Two figures emerge from the woods and stop at the edge of the clearing.

They are apparently human beings, but they look like creatures out of the prehistoric past. They are clothed only in loin cloths and are barefooted.

One is a middle-aged man, of Japanese descent, about fifty, of medium height, fairly tanned, stockily-built, and covered with hair almost from head to foot.

The other is apparently his son, a lad of about 14, husky, with thick black hair on his head and a light covering of hirsute on his body.

The boy asks, "Pop, what are those broken down trucks lined up in a row over there?"

"That, my boy, is what remains of Rohwer relocation center."

The boy was puzzled. "What was that, pop?"

"Well, my son, over a hundred years ago, at the outbreak of the Great War, all people of Japanese ancestry were evacuated from the West coast and placed in centers. This was one of those centers, and over 12,000 people lived here at one time or another during the three years that it existed."

"Where did they all go, pop?"

"They scattered out, son. Relocation they called it. Some went east, others went north to places like Chicago, and others returned to California."

"Where is California, pop?"

"California, my son, is on the Pacific coast. It used to be one of our great states, until it withdrew from the union."

"Why did it withdraw, pop?"

"Because they wanted to (continued on page 4)

NAKANO IS VICTIM OF TRUCK ACCIDENT

Eijiro Nakano, 74, was the unlucky victim of a truck accident in which he was struck down by a moving truck and run over.

He died at the hospital shortly after of a brain concussion.

According to the report compiled by the Internal Security, the driver of the truck was backing up, and could not see Nakano, who was walking in the same direction in which the truck was moving.

The person on the back of the canvassed vehicle had his back turned to Nakano, as he was preparing mail bags for the next block, so could not see him.

No charges were made against the driver.

Funeral services for Nakano will be held this afternoon. He is survived by a wife, Matsuno, 63, who resides at 28-6F.

WASHINGTON: FAVOR RETURN OF EVACUEES IN BELLVUE

Sentiment overwhelmingly in favor of permitting loyal Japanese Americans to return to their West Coast homes and farms was expressed at a meeting of more than 700 persons in the auditorium of Overlake Grade School at Bellvue, according to the Seattle Post-Intelligencer.

Two officers of the anti-Japanese Remember Pearl Harbor League, George Westbeau of Auburn and C. Nifty Garrett of Sumner, were said to have come off "decidedly second best" in a question and answer period which followed three programmed addresses, one by Harold Pistone, War Relocation Authority area director.

rollment is at present about 300 students, the normal enrollment in peacetime being in excess of 600. A room has been reserved already for the prospective scholarship student for the 1945 fall term. In addition to this \$100 scholarship, it may be possible for the girl to obtain a yearly loan of \$150 from the college without interest, 15 per cent of the debt to be cancelled if she graduates from the University.

She may also secure a part-time job, working ten hours weekly and earning a total of \$130 for the year, or working for her full board and earning about \$25 a month.

Employment and housing opportunities in Decatur are good, so that a daughter wishing to apply for the scholarship might be able to relocate her entire family with her.
