HUNDREDS OF NEW ARRIVALS EXPECTED OVER WEEKEND!

Colonists of the city of Poston, today, are preparing to welcome hundreds of new arrivals from many points in Southern California and San Joaquin Valley, who are expected to arrive here this afternoon by bus and train.

The Intake Center staff will be on hand to welcome them in it's new quarters in the Mess Hall of Block 14. The Poston Police Dept. will be on hand to control traffic, and to seek the cooperation of colonists in maintaining lines so that the new arrivals can be ushered through the various departments of Intake, Registration, Housing and Medical.

We are expecting approximately 888 new arrivals.
