

IKI FARM, EVACUEE WORKERS REACH NEW LABOR CONTRACT AGREEMENT

Week-end negotiations between the workers from Poston and the Moapa Valley farmers resulted in a new agreement, Edward Noss-off, senior administrative assistant in the Employment Division announced yesterday on his return from investigation reports of bad working conditions in Logandale, Nevada.

The contract now guarantees at least 40 full working days from April 5 to May 25 to workers from both Poston and Topaz who are now in Logandale at wages approved by the workers. In event of a dispute, the committees for the parties involved are empowered to negotiate a decision with a WRA representative to act as arbiter in cases where an agreement cannot be reached.

Also planned is a meeting with the workers who were left behind to see what they desire as settlement for their loss of time. Noss-off invited representatives of these workers to see him at the Project Employment Office and arrange a date for the meeting.

Noss-off declared that the "IKI Farms," contractor of the workers, had over-recruited and misrepresented itself as the "farmer," and as a result had been eliminated from the present agreement by the consent of both the growers and the workers.

Misrepresentation of working conditions by employers or labor contractors will not be tolerated by WRA," Noss-off said. "As in this case, agents misrepresenting their own status will be eliminated from the picture as soon as the facts are determined."

The government, it was stated, is considering filing a criminal complaint against IKI Farms for its part in the deal.

The POSITION LAMP

A FEW TIPS ON OUTSIDE EMPLOYMENT: Don't count too much on getting accommodated by the hostels. At present there are two in Chicago, their combined capacity, about 30, and there are 107,000 of us in the center. In a word, your word, your chance of getting a room there, is very slim...The purpose of the hostels is to enable the employer and the worker to meet face to face and if satisfactory, he'll take you and you'll have to secure accommodations elsewhere..... The State of Kansas is still dry.

The Friends Service Committee and the WRA is working on the Eastern Defense Command to enable Japanese to enter that area with a little less red tape. The Command seems to feel that the Western Defense Command evacuated us for security reasons and, if we were dangerous on the West Coast, then we shouldn't be allowed to run around loose out there either. This the WRA and the Friends, hope to overcome...Cash grants will make it possible for most anyone to leave for outside employment, but, don't get the idea, you can secure a grant and take a joy ride to Chicago with the dough--if you get a grant, you're going out to work and not for a joy ride on the WRA...A Federal Security Agency will be set up to take care of you, in case of illness and you're caught with your pants down--no molash.

Don't take a domestic job unless you intend to make that your life work. If you take a position, stay a few weeks and walk out on your employer
