RESIDENTS DEMAND POSTON NOODLES

The Unit I Local Council instructed the food committee and also a three-man committee from the noodle factory to confer jointly with C.E. Snelson, Chief Steward, and recommend the reopening of the noodle factory. It was stated at the weekly Unit I Local Council meeting held in the Conference room, June 16.

This recommendation was agreed upon after it was clearly shown in a survey taken by the councilmen of their respective blocks, that the majority of the blocks liked the noodle, manufactured here in Unit I. 18 blocks were in favor of noodle and 13 blocks in opposition, with the remaining blk undecided or not having any representatives as yet on the Council.

In an earlier survey conducted by the food committee, 98% of the mess halls were in favor of the reopening of the noodle factory with one mess hall opposed and an another undecided.

However, it was disclosed that there was a difference in question asked by the food committee and the councilmen. The food committee based its survey upon the question of, if the mess halls wanted the noodle factory to reopen again, but the councilmen asked their blocks, if the residents liked the noodle manufactured here in Unit I.

The noodle factory was forced to close some three weeks ago, upon orders of the Chief Steward, who stat-

ed that there were some Canton noodle and egg noodle in the warehouse, which must be eaten first.

But as one source stated, it just doesn't seem right to close the factory, when subsistence for the coming fiscal year, beginning July 1, is to be cut from 45 cents to 51 cents per person per day.

JOBS OFFERED TO STRANDED NYA TRAINEES

Substantial progress in finding jobs for the young men and women affected by NYA's cancellation of its agreement to provide vocational training in resident centers is reported by WRA.

According to information received from the Twin Cities, no difficulty is being experienced in placing the 75 youths enrolled in vocational training courses in Minneapolis and St. Paul. Public-spirited citizens and NYA regional officials are cooperating with WRA relocation officers in finding jobs in that area.

Twenty-eight of the young people in training at Salk Lake City who returned to Minidoka are now preparing to leave for Cleveland and Chicago where jobs have

REJECTS GIVEN JOB PRIORITY

Special efforts are being made to secure outside employment opportunities for combat team volunteers who were not accepted because of physical deficiencies or age, according to John C. Baker, Chief of the Reports Office.

To aid Relocation Supervisor in finding suitable job openings, the Project Leave Officer is sending to each relocation office a list of the names, occupational preferences, and background of all volunteers who did not pass the physical examinations.

Men on this list will be given first priority both in clearance through the War Department Joint Board (which establishes eligibility for war plant work) and in connection with ordinary employment opportunities which are received at the center.

From Des Moines, Iowa, it is reported that several Manzanar NYA trainees have been placed, and a WRA relocation supervisor is now in the area looking for schools in which owners can continue their training.

Young people enrolled at the NYA centers who have not yet been placed are being provided with food and housing by the WRA and will be furnished with transportation to the place of employment as soon as job opportunities for them can be found.
