POSTON PENAL CODE STUDIED AT COUNCIL MEETING

The Poston Community Council convened last Thursday morning, July 22 in Unit III and analytically studied the proposed Penal Code for this project. Because the document is so very comprehensive, the legislative body set up a committee to make further study of

the Code. The committee consists of Messrs. Terakawa, Fukuda, Kubota, Masuda, and Kuroiwa. This group is to submit any recommendations or corrections on the Penal Code at the next meeting of the Council.

A standing committee to be in charge of all future send-offs of Army Volunteers from Poston was proposed by the Council. Tom Sakai, Unit I, and Gerald Wumino, Unit III, were recommended that the chairman choose three persons from Unit I and two each from Units II and III, to act on the committee. The send-off of the Volunteers leaving this Sunday is being planned by another group.

A new treasurer for the Council, Mr. Kawasaki, was named at the special meeting.

SIX RECOMMENDATIONS RELEASED FOR MANPOWER REDUCTION

Suggestions for effecting a 10% reduction in the Center work force by July 31 as justly as possible were sent to all branch chiefs and division and section heads this week.

Six recommendations offered by the Joint Manpower Commission as guidance to department heads for selecting

the persons to be terminated were as follows:

1. Their lack of ability to perform their duties and their inexperience on the job. Consideration should be given to cheerful, willing and qualified workers.

2. Persons who have not been given full attention to their jobs, who have not worked their allotted time, and who do not seem to have any appreciation for the work they are doing.

3. Wherever possible, no family should be left without one wage earner within the family. Whenever practical, family heads should be retained.

4. When the above suggestions have been followed attention should be given to seniority of workers within the section.

5. When it is necessary to make a reduction of a number of workers it might be possible to arrange some sort of a shift method of employment.

6. When the above suggestions do not seem adequate, a straw ballot may be taken.

UNEMPLOYMENT COMPENSATION CLARIFIED

The Employment Division today clarified the circumstances under which residents would be eligible for unemployment compensation.

In accordance with Administrative Instruction 27, Supplement 2, eligibility of evacuees to receive unemployment compensation shall be limited to those actively engaged in WRA project employment, who are unable to report to work due to illness, and who present a statement from a physician certifying to this fact. Employment Division stated.

HEALTH DEPT. URGES "SHOTS" FOR CHILDREN

The Public Health Dept. of Poston urges that all children be given the protective treatments against smallpox, diphtheria, whooping cough and typhoid fever which are available from the clinic by appointments, according to a memorandum to the Chronicle.

The department states that any child that has been protected from the four diseases will be given a "certificate of Immunity", which should be preserved and shown whenever the child enters a new school.

BOSTON WIDE CLEAN-UP DAY SET

Acting upon the recommendation of the Project Director, Wade Head, the Community Council of Poston set aside the last Saturday of each month as Clean-up Day in Poston.

The Community Council left the method of conducting the campaign up to the Local Council of each unit.

The Local Council of Unit III at their last meeting, decided to work this campaign through the Block Managers Staff. As this campaign is for the benefit of the residents, full cooperation will be necessary to make it a success.

Mark Kadotani was appointed Unit III representative to Trustee of the Hospital Fund. Dr. M. M. Nakadate was appointed Prosecuting Attorney of Unit III.
