

POSTON ORGANIZES YOUTH COUNSELLING BOARD

Poston's Unit I Block Managers in cooperation with almost every major organization in Unit I have formed a Youth Counselling Board to combat juvenile delinquency in this unit. Seeing a necessity for such an organization due to an increase of petty crime among the minors, the block managers immediately appointed the Executive Committee, which is composed of one block manager from each quad, which in turn appointed Dick Nishimoto, Sumida and Tom Sakai to draft rules and regulations for the board.

After many weeks of conference and investigations, the following set of rules and regulations were established:

The Unit I Local Council Chairman, Block Manager Supervisor of Unit I, Chairman of Unit Executive Board, and Unit II Administrator shall select or appoint the personnel of the Board and determine the number of people.

The Youth Counselling Board shall investigate any and all cases involving juvenile delinquency and make recommendations to the Judicial Commission; the Project Director; the Police Department, or to any other official or department; also act as probation officers for juvenile delinquents and to act generally as a Counselling Board; hear all matters involving minors under the age of eighteen years referred to it by the Judicial Commission, and shall also hear all other matters involving the moral or delinquent conduct.

CAMP SAVAGE RECRUITERS TO ARRIVE TONIGHT

Expected in the Center tonight is Lt. Col Karl T. Gould, director of personnel at Camp Savage, who will interview candidates for the Army Language School, beginning tomorrow and continuing until Wednesday.

On Monday, applicants in Camp III may contact Lt. Col. Gould in Unit Administrator, Morris Burge's office. Subsequently, he will be in Units II and I; in James Crawford's office on Tuesday, and Ralph Gelvin's office on Wednesday.

Any male who can understand Japanese is qualified, and a profound knowledge of Japanese is not necessarily required.

Current recruiting is in line with the program of expansion at Camp Savage, resulting from the excellent services rendered by nisei graduates of the school in the Pacific theater.

Because it was imperative to preserve military secrecy, many details about the nature of the training at Camp Savage have not been revealed. In some quarters this has created misunderstanding.

To aid in an erroneous belief, Col. Kai Rasmussen, commandant at Camp Savage, recently emphasized that the primary objective of the training was to prepare men to be skilled language specialists.

"This school is by no means a training school for spies," he declared.

RED CROSS COURSES TO START MONDAY
