Beautification of the grounds in Poston is one of the many projects handled by the Agriculture Dept.

Requisitions for roses, flowering vines, climbers and trailers, flower seeds, shrubs and trees have already been made for immediate planting, according to Harry Kikuchi of the Nursery Division.

With irrigation these native plants are expected to survive in this climate.

Eggplant beds have been prepared between fire-breaks and Bldgs, in Block 42. Plants for 24 acres will be planted for later distribution to individuals, who desire them. The Black Beauty variety will be set out and will be harvested before the frost.
